

Our wines: White wines



Roero Arneis

- Name of vineyard: San Michele, Renesio, Tanone, Vallupera, Bastia, Colla
- Soil: calcareous, sandy, clayey
- Variety: 100% Arneis
- Training system: Guyot with fruit bearing canes of 7-9 buds
- Harvested by hand
- Vinification method: soft crushing of the grapes. Alcoholic fermentation under controlled temperature for about 20 days
- Ageing: The wine is kept on the yeast in stainless steel vats until bottling
- Color: Straw yellow
- Nose: Floral and fruity
- Taste: Hints of white and citrus fruits, notes of savoury and freshness
- Best with: Aperitifs, appetizers, fish
- Serve at: 10°-12° C
- 12 bottles Cases - bottle 0,75 - cork or screw cup closure
